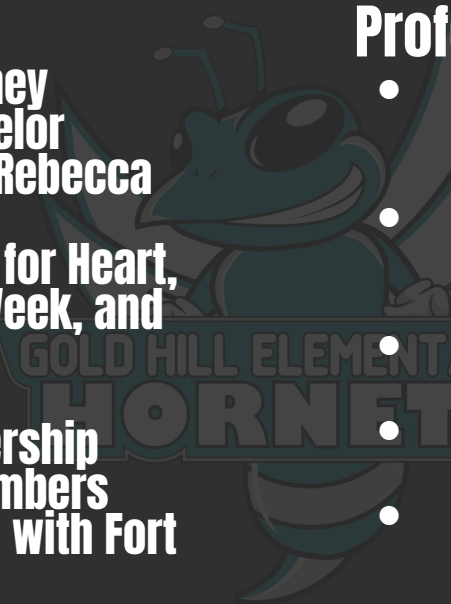

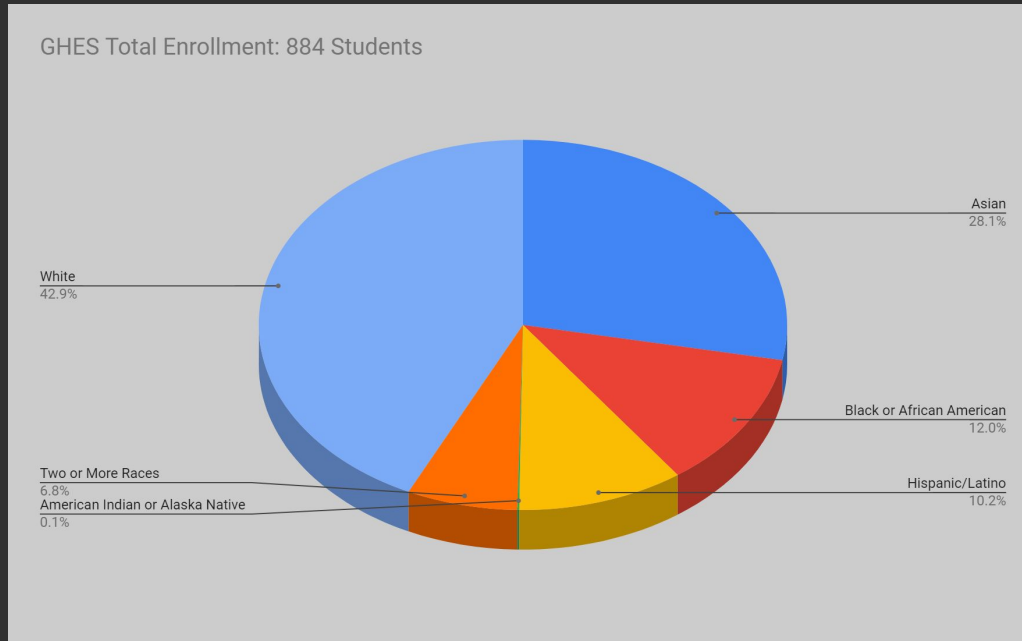

# Enrollment

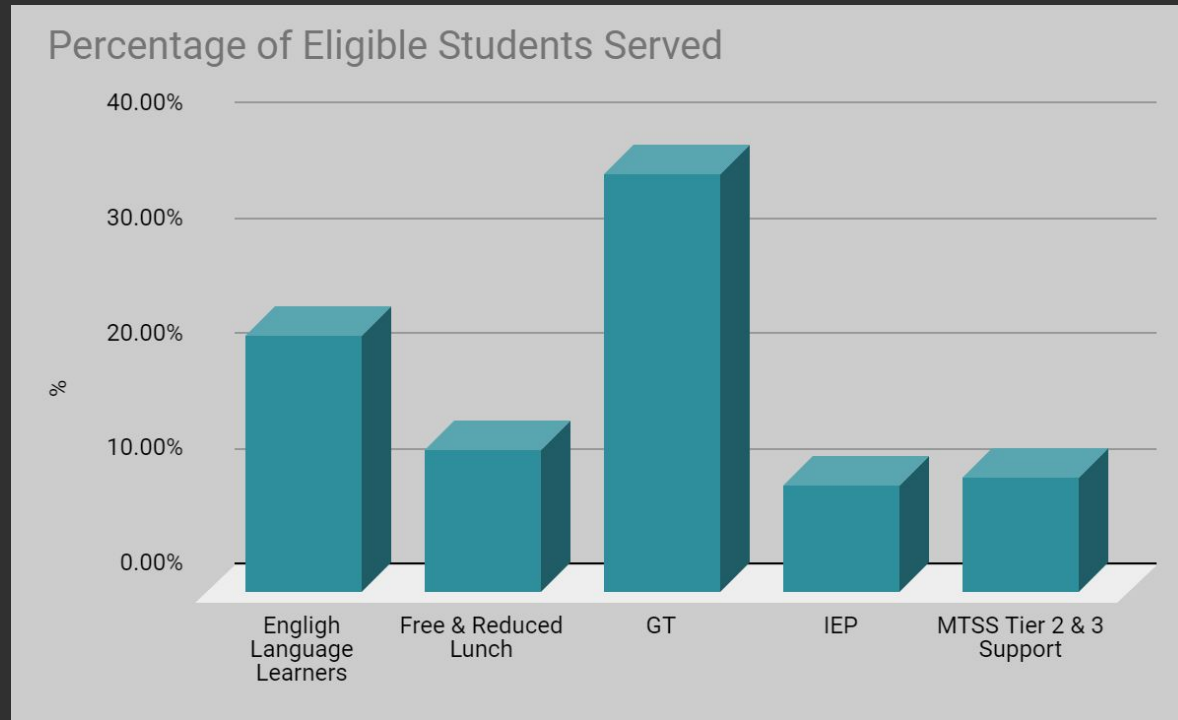

# Support Services



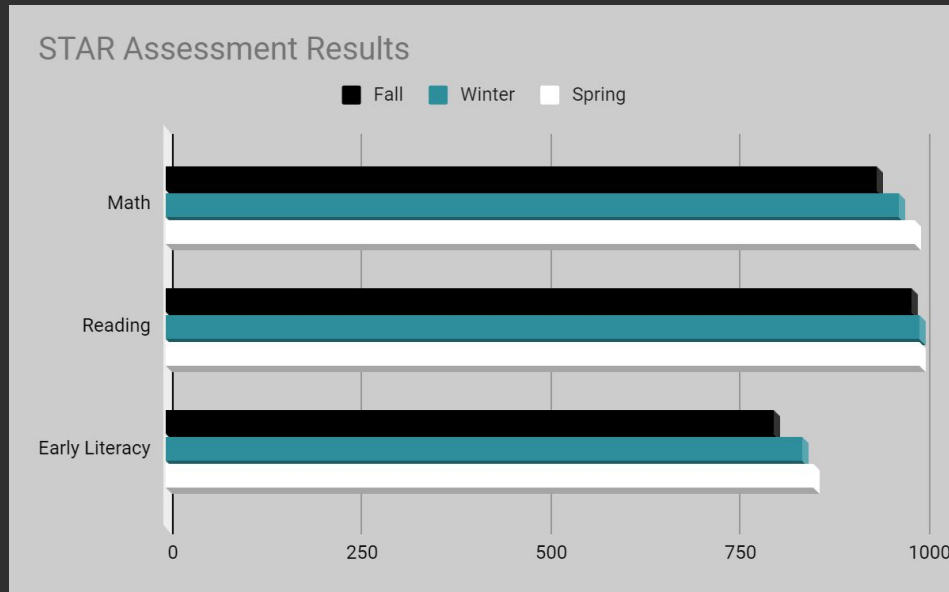
**Our school offers a variety of support services to meet the physical, academic, behavioral, and social/emotional needs of our students.**
